**SUB: Pending 80 % Arrear of College and University Teachers of West Bengal to be received from Central Government (MHRD)**

Respected Sir,

With reference to my conversation with Mr. Harpreet Singh, Director, MHRD over the telephone on 16th May 2013, followed by my letter to him on the said issue I beg to inform that our State Government has already paid the concerned teachers their total arrears ranging from 1.04.2009 to 31.03. 2010.

I was informed by Mr. Singh that the money would be given to the State Government through reimbursement, and a claim for the above amount (approximately Rs 202 crores) has already been sent to the Department of MHRD by the Department of Higher Education, West Bengal. I was reported by Mr. Singh that they have already examined and re-examined the claim and are waiting for an undertaking from the Department of Higher Education West Bengal that this thirteen-month arrear has actually been paid to the teachers of our state (i.e. from 1.04.2009 to 31.03. 2010).

Sir, under the circumstances I plead in all humility to take necessary action so that the undertaking is sent to the MHRD without delay. Mr. Singh has promised to reimburse the money in no time. Once this amount is received from the Central Government our State Government can immediately disburse a heavy installment to our teachers. This we hope will serve for general content among teachers in Colleges and Universities, and also may allay those who have filed litigations against our Government in this connection.

Please find enclosed herewith copies of all correspondences made by WBCUPA to MHRD and the Higher Education Department West Bengal in this regard.

We earnestly look forward to your kind initiative in this matter.

This is to inform you that with reference to my conversation with Mr Harpreet Singh Director, MHRD on 17.05.2013 over the telephone I was made informed that MHRD has taken a decision to reimburse our pending arrear to the State Government. I informed Mr Singh in my letter dated 21.05.2013 that the Government of West Bengal has already paid the thirteen month arrear from 1.04.2009 to 31.03.2010, the reimbursement of which from MHRD is pending for a long time. I was also informed by Mr Singh in his letter dated 21.05.2013 that though the claim for reimbursement has been received from the Government of West Bengal , an Undertaking would be required for the same. We are made assured from the Department of Higher Education Government of West Bengal that all necessary documents including the UNDERTAKING have been sent to MHRD by 21.06.2013.

Most humbly on behalf of my organization (the West Bengal College and University Professors Association) may I plead that the reimbursement be made at the earliest. The State Government has already fulfilled its due responsibility by paying the thirteen months installment three years ago.
